

1. Document Setup

- **Trim Size (Final Size):** Set to exact postcard dimensions (e.g., 4"x6", 5"x7", etc.)
 - **Bleed:** Minimum 0.125" (3 mm) bleed on all sides
 - **Safe Zone (Margin):** Keep critical content (text/logos) at least 0.125" (3 mm) inside the trim line

2. Colour Mode & Profiles

- **CMYK Colour Mode:** Convert all elements and images to CMYK (not RGB)
 - **Colour Profile:** Recommended: U.S. Web Coated (SWOP) v2
 - **Spot Colours:** Convert spot/Pantone colours to CMYK if not using foil

3. Typography

- **Fonts Embedded or Outlined:** Ensure all fonts are embedded or converted to outlines
 - **Minimum Font Size:** 6 pt for readability (especially on dark backgrounds)
 - **Black Text:** Use 100% K (not rich black) for small text

4. Images & Graphics

- **Resolution:** Minimum 300 DPI at final size
 - **Image Format:** Use high-quality formats (TIFF, PSD, or maximum-quality JPEGs)
 - **Linked Files:** All images should be embedded or packaged with the file

5. Bleeds, Crop Marks, and Layout

- **Bleed Area:** Extend background images/colours into the bleed
 - **Crop Marks:** Include crop marks if required, offset from the bleed area
 - **Single Page Layouts:** One page per side (Front and Back), not imposed/spread
-

6. File Formats

- **Preferred Format:** High-resolution PDF
- **Other Accepted Formats:** AI, INDD (with packaged links/fonts), EPS, TIFF (flattened)
- **File Naming:** Clear and specific (e.g., Postcard_Front.pdf, Postcard_Back.pdf)
